Dives include Peak Performance Buoyancy, Underwater Naturalist, Navigation, Night, Deep and Boat. Six Open Water Dives from the boat and shore. Upon successful completion of this course, students receive the Jr. Advanced Open Water Certification. The Jr. Advanced Open Water Certification is a prerequisite to the Rescue Diver Camp. This course also counts toward the Jr. Master Scuba Diver rating, the highest rating in non-professional recreational scuba diving.
