



Advanced Scuba Camp



This is a great opportunity to expand your diving experience with the PADI Adventures in Diving Program (the Advanced Open Water Course). Dives include Peak Performance Buoyancy, Underwater Naturalist, Navigation, Night, Deep and Boat. This totals six open water dives from the boat and shore. Upon successful completion of this course, students receive the Junior Advanced Open Water Certification. The Junior Advanced Open Water Certification is a prerequisite to the Rescue Diver Camp. This course also counts toward the Junior Master Scuba Diver rating, the highest rating in non-professional recreational scuba diving.
