



Open Water SCUBA Camp



This is the real deal – Open Water Diver certification! Students need to prepare by reading the PADI Open Water Diver Manual, watching the Open Water Diver DVD, and completing all Knowledge Reviews. Course includes academics sessions, shallow water skill dives, and four Open Water dives – two from the shore and two from the boat! Upon successful completion of the program, students will receive the PADI Jr. Open Water certification.

COST:

- \$350 plus tax & materials

- Ages 10 -11 (must be Master Seal Team members, have instructor approval and based on space availability)

- Pool: Watermanship assessment - 10 min tread & 200 yard swim

DAY 3 (9 am - 3 pm)

- Preparation: Read and watch Module 5
- Preparation: Answer Knowledge Reviews 5 & prepare for test
- Classroom: Academics 5 & test
- Pool: Shallow Water SCUBA skills

DAY 4 SHORE DIVES! (9 am - 4 pm)

- Prepare items for beach day - gear, logbook, tables, hat, sunscreen, lunch, snacks, water bottle (Before class)
- Shore: Open Water Dives 1 & 2
- Classroom: Log Dives

DAY 5 BOAT DIVES! (8 am - 4 pm)

- Prepare items for boat day - gear, logbook, tables, hat, sunscreen, lunch, snacks, water bottle (Before class)
- Boat: Open Water Dives 3 & 4
- Classroom: Log Dives, certifications issued upon completion
- Pool: Celebration and Cake

PADI is the Professional Association of Diving Instructors -- the world's largest scuba certification agency. Cancellations must be made 72 hours or more in advance or charge will be incurred.
