Manta Ray Diver



The population of manta rays on the Kona Coast of Hawaii have been thrilling divers and snorkelers for years. These majestic animals glide, pivot, and somersault as they feed on plankton attracted to underwater lights. Students will learn about the life cycle of the manta, manta anatomy, and manta research done right here in Kona. Students will go on three Sunset/Night Manta Dive charters for a total of six open water dives. Students must have their Jr. Advanced Open Water certification or higher to participate in this camp. Upon successful completion of this course, students receive the PADI Manta Ray Diver Specialty certification. This specialty certification will count toward the Master Scuba Diver rating.

COST:

PREREQUISITES:

- Ages 12 -18
- Junior Advanced Open Water certification or higher
- Bring certification card

STUDENTS TO PROVIDE:

- Swimsuit, towel, sunscreen

- Mask, snorkel, fins and underwater timing device
- PADI Recreational Dive Planner (eRDP or tables)
- Log Book
- *Manta Rays of Hawaii* - given with registration materials
- *PADI Adventures in Diving* (Advanced Open Water Manual)

REGISTRATION:

- Pre-register at Jack's Diving Locker in advance and pick up registration and course materials.
- Student record folder/waivers: Complete student record folder (new students) or fill out new class waivers and medical history form (existing students) with student and parent signatures.
- Medical history form: Parents fill out for children. If any questions have been answered **YES**, student must have a doctor's approval **before** starting camp. Parents please get the medical release for the doctor from the shop first.

DISCOUNTS:

- 15% off most regular priced merchandise during class
- 10% off most regular priced merchandise after completion
- \$5.00 off dives

All courses include instruction by PADI certified Instructors and Divemasters. All camps follow PADI course outlines. PADI is the Professional Association of Diving Instructors -- the world's largest scuba certification agency. Cancellations must be made 72 hours or more in advance or charge will be incurred. Minimum 3, Maximum 6 students.

Master Scuba Diver Rating:

The Master Scuba Diver rating is the highest PADI designation in non-professional recreational diving. To achieve this rating, divers must complete the following certifications: Open Water, Advanced Open Water, Rescue Diver, and 5 Specialties. In addition, divers must have at least 50 logged dives. When completing this rating with Jack's Diving Locker, recipients have their names engraved in a plaque to honor their achievement.
