This week long day camp is filled with fun and adventure for certified divers who want to learn more about diving. First, students will review and have a chance to improve basic scuba skills with refresher dives in the pool and off shore. Next, students will learn about amazing marine life and aquatic ecology with the PADI UW Naturalist Specialty course. In addition, students get to study and identify reef fish in the PADI AWARE Fish ID Specialty course. These specialties count toward the Master Scuba Diver rating, the highest rating in non-professional recreational scuba diving. In this camp, students will do both shore and boat dives with a total of 6 Open Water Dives!

- Ages 12 -18
- Junior Open Water certification of higher
- Bring certification card

Master Scuba Diver Rating:

The Master Scuba Diver rating is the highest PADI designation in non-professional recreational diving. To achieve this rating, divers must complete the following certifications: Open Water, Advanced Open Water, Rescue Diver, and 5 Specialties. In addition, divers must have at least 50 logged dives. When completing this rating with Jack's Diving Locker, recipients have their names engraved in a plaque to honor their achievement.

All courses include instruction by PADI certified Instructors and Divemasters. All camps follow PADI course outlines. PADI is the Professional Association of Diving Instructors -- the world's largest scuba certification agency. Cancellations must be made 72 hours or more in advance or charge will be incurred. Minimum 3, Maximum 6 students.
