Divemasters supervise a variety of dive activities such as guiding certified divers on underwater tours and assisting instructors with student divers. This course involves a combination of knowledge development, diving skills, and stamina testing along with an extensive internship program in real courses with real students in real diving situations. The Jack's Diving Locker Divemaster schedule is for students participating in the eLearning option.

- 18 years old
- Medical Statement signed within the past year
- 40 logged dives
