



Manta Ray Diver Specialty Course



Learn about our famous Kona Manta Rays in the original PADI Manta Ray Diver Specialty course. This program includes two dives on the Sunset/Night Manta Ray Dive trip along with an academic session prior to the dives. Based on research conducted by Keller Laros since 1991, this specialty course covers information about manta anatomy, feeding, cleaning, and reproduction as well as how to identify individual rays in the local population. Conservation guidelines and proper diving technique will also be covered. The PADI Manta Ray Diver Specialty certification will count toward the PADI Master Scuba Diver rating – the highest rating in recreational scuba diving.

CLASS SCHEDULE:

- Classroom: Manta Ray Diver Specialty Exam
- Boat: Sunset and Night Dives
- Classroom: Fill out Logbook
- Certification issued upon successful completion of course

Note: Although manta ray sightings are very consistent throughout the year, this certification does not require a manta sighting.

Master Scuba Diver Rating:

The PADI Master Scuba Diver rating is the highest rating in non-professional recreational diving. To achieve this rating the diver must complete the following certifications: Open Water Diver, Advanced Open Water Diver, Rescue Diver, and 5 PADI Specialty courses. In addition, divers must have at least 50 logged dives. When completing these requirements at Jack's Diving Locker, recipients will have their names engraved on a plaque to honor this achievement.
